THE JURORS FOR THE STATE UPON THEIR OATH PRESENT that on or about the 30th day of October, 2014, in Mecklenburg County, Patrick Deangelo Cannon did unlawfully, willfully and feloniously vote in a general election after having been convicted of a felony in the United States District Court for the Western District of North Carolina without having his suffrage and/or citizenship rights restored, to wit:- The Defendant pled guilty to felony corruption charges in the United States District Court for the Western District of North Carolina on June 3, 2014 and was sentenced to forty-four (44) months in federal prison on or about October 14, 2014. On October 30, 2014 the defendant voted in the 2014 General Election at the early voting site at Ballantyne Village in Mecklenburg County, during the time in which his citizenship and suffrage rights had not been restored.
