The City of Charlotte a Municipal Corporation in the
County of Mecklenburg and State of North Carolina party of the second part

WITNESSETH, That the said party of the first part, in consideration and in pursuance of Resolution
said Board hereinafter recited by its authority & direction ~~and in consideration of~~ ~~and~~ Dollars

to it paid by the party of the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, hath
bargained, and sold, and by these Presents doth grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part
and its successors white and yellow as it is used & maintained for the purpose
hereinafter mentioned all that certain tract or parcel ~~of land situate, lying and being in~~ Charlotte Township Mecklenburg County, State of

adjoining the lands of Brevard & Springs ~~the Highland Park Co. O L Barringer & others bounded as follows:~~ Beginning at a stone near
the Boiling St. Park Spring ~~at corner of the Highland Park Co. property~~
and running with said Co's line N 10^{1/2} E 2^{1/2} Egg ft to a stone on the South side
of Seventh Street ~~at corner of the Brevard and Springs property~~ thence with

Bank of Sugar Creek corner Brevard and Spring's land thence down the creek
with its various courses 219 ft to a stone thence with Barringers lines
862 E 310 ft to a stone near the Pumping Station thence S 35 1/2 E 274 ft
to a stone in a bottom Barringer's corner thence (part of this line with Barringer)
S 55 E 1060 ft to a stone thence S 35 1/2 E 579 3/4 ft to a stone thence S 76 1/2 E 726
ft to a stone a corner of the Highland Park Co's property thence with 3 lines

This land is granted and conveyed to the grantee herein as and for a
public park for the use of white people and it is to be held, used & maintained
by the grantee and its successors for that purpose and none other and whenever the
grantee herein or its successors cease to keep and maintain said property for
the purposes aforesaid same is at once to revert to the grantor herein to
successors and assigns and this conveyance is executed in pursuance of
under authority of a Resolution unanimously passed by the Grantor Board
at a regular meeting held on the 8th day of July 1904 authorizing the
